Our Goals for Student Achievement

Tornillo ISD Schools set goals for the entire district. The district goals for 2021 - 2022 are:

District Goals

 Students performing at the Meets Grade Level Standard on STAAR Reading grade 3rd – 8th, EOC English I & English II will increase from 31% in 2019 to 49% by 2024.

 Students performing at the Meets Grade Level Standard on STAAR Math grades 3rd – 8th and EOC Algebra I will increase from 34% in June 2019 to 49% by June 2024.

 Students graduating college, career and military ready will increase from 78% in June 2019 to 90% by June 2024.



Teachers, Students, Families – Together for Success

In Tornillo Junior High School

Classrooms:

Teachers will work with students and their families to support student success in reading and math.

Teachers will:

- Provide families with a newsletter that features the skills for the week which can be reviewed at home.
- Provide families with reading skills and math practice activities to work with students at home.
- Provide families with reading material and question stems specific to the student's reading level to read with student at home.
- Provide families with information about school wide events to learn academic strategies for families to practice at home.

At Home

TJHS families joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support student success in reading and math. Families will:

- Read the provided books at home for at least 20-30 minutes each night.
- Ask the provided questions about what students have read.
- Use the reading materials provided to work with students at home.
- Use the math practice activities provided at home.
- Attend school wide events to learn academic strategies to utilize at home.
