






IMPACT OF DUAL CREDIT ON OUR COMMUNITY

- Provide a quality education and an opportunity for high school students to excel in college. Dual Credit students have higher GPAs (3.7 vs 2.7) and are twice as likely to graduate from EPCC in 3 years or less than those who never took Dual Credit.*
- Dual Credit is an excellent indicator of **student success**. Students are more likely to persist, succeed, and avoid developmental courses.
- Students and parents save significantly on the costs of tuition, fees, and textbooks for every course taken.
- 63.22% of ECHS students earn a post-secondary degree or certificate <u>before</u> high school graduation and have earned close to 7,000 degrees and certificates.

8 OF THE 88TH TEXAS LEGISLATURE - FUNDING

- Financial Aid for Swift Transfer (FAST) \$55 per credit for educationally disadvantaged students, currently close to 75%
- Performance Tier Dual Credit students earning 15 credits
- Performance Tier Associate Degrees, Certificate I or II
 40% of all AAs earned by ECHS students

EL PASO ON BUTTY CON

ECHS AND P-TECH DESIGNATION COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS SCHOOL MODELS (CCRSM)

- ECHS must have an Institution of Higher Education (IHE) partner
- P-TECHS must have an IHE and a Business & Industry partner who can provide Work-Based Learning (WBL) opportunities
- Both follow a Blueprint which consists of 5 Benchmarks. This presentation is part of Benchmark I - School Design
- Both must meet Outcomes Based Measures (OBMs) in Access, Achievement, and Attainment (9 and 15 credit hours; core complete; associate degree).
- Both start as Provisional and can become Designated, Designated with Distinction, or Needs Improvement after the first four years.


