

Credit Averaging

When a student earns a passing grade in only half a course and the combined grade for both halves is a 70 or above, and the compulsory attendance laws have been met, the District shall award the student credit for both halves under the following guidelines:

1. Regular coursed may be averaged with Pre-AP, Pre-IB, AP/IB, or dual credit courses.
2. Regular courses may be averaged with special education courses.
3. Regular coursed may be averaged with credit by examination. The student must obtain a passing score (i.e. 70 for credit by examination with prior instruction and 80 for credit by examination without prior instruction) in order to average a credit by examination score with regular courses.
4. Courses may be averaged from one year to another year.
5. Regular courses may be averaged with summer school courses.
6. Regular and advanced courses may be averaged with approved computer-based courses.
7. Courses taken in middle school that qualify for high school credit may be credit averaged.
8. Courses taken in the District may be average with courses taken in other Texas districts only.
